- January 21-31** **Recruited members for the Big Sister Peer-Mentoring Program**
Applications were distributed to the Mechanical Design Technology classes. Twelve (12) students and six (6) industry professionals/mentors joined. Eight (8) big sister-little sister groups were formed.
- February 26** **Met with MVCC advisors and counselors**
Presented and explained to the advising and counseling departments the modified and new certificates in the Mechanical Design Technology program. Updated them on the status of the Big Sister Peer-Mentoring program.
- March 7** **Held the Spring-2003 Peer-Mentoring dinner meeting**
Seven student members, four corporate mentors and two MVCC faculty/staff attended the meeting.
